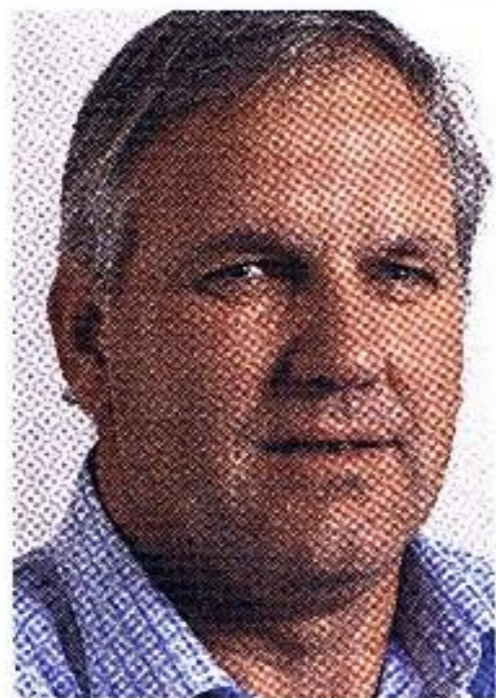


COMINGS & GOINGS
